

Traffic Signal - Loudoun County Parkway and Edgewater Street – Timeline and Summary

Summary: This signal is being installed under a proffer from Toll Brothers that is still outstanding from the original South Riding rezoning. The signal has met VDOT warrant requirements. The project is expected to last 4-5 months, weather permitting, and the signal should be operational in 2024.

11/21/24: We noticed them digging again in this area last week. They are closing out VDOT punch list matters.

5/23/24: The traffic light has been functioning for a couple weeks now. We hope this improves the safety of those traveling through our community.

5/2/24: Signal is now on flash to alert drivers that the light will be active soon. Per VDOT the signal will flash till Tuesday 5/7 and will then turn on to normal function.

4/5/24: Toll Brothers contractor is still estimating the light to be complete by May, then turned over to VDOT for programming and operational sometime this summer.

2/26/24: The traffic light poles are up.



2/5/24: Toll Brothers contractor is now estimating the light to be complete by May, then turned over to VDOT for programming and operational hopefully by the summer.

1/2/24: Toll Brothers last update projected spring 2024 for operation of the light.
